SWITCH Design Competition 2023 Terms and Conditions

Period: 1 May 2023 - 1 December 2023

General

1. This SWITCH Design Competition ("Competition") is organised and conducted by ACDC Express CC and Infinity Brands (Pty) Ltd, including its affiliates, associations, and agents ("Promoters").
2. This Competition will allow entries from 1 May 2023 to 31 August 2023, with the final winners being announced on 1 December 2023. Entries received after the closing date will not be considered.
3. Participants must be a South African citizen or permanent resident in the Republic of South Africa ("RSA"), and have a valid identity document or passport and reside in the RSA during the period of the Competition ("Participants"/"you"/"your").
4. Participants may not enter or receive a prize if they are directors, members, partners, employees, agents or consultants of the Promoters, their subsidiaries, holding companies, divisions, and/or associated companies or of the advertising or promotion agencies or any other person who directly or indirectly controls or is controlled by the Promoters, or their spouses, life partners, immediate family members or business partners. This includes employees from ACDC Express, ACDC Dynamics and Infinity Brands.
5. By entering this Competition, all Participants agree to be bound by these terms and conditions, and the Promoters' decision regarding any issue with the Competition will be final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. No responsibility will be accepted for any entry that is not delivered, received or is delayed or damaged due to technical reasons, including electronic mail failure of the part of the Participant's service provider, or otherwise. Proof of sending is not proof of receipt.
7. To participate in the campaign you must:
 - 7.1. Be a South African citizen or permanent resident of the RSA;



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- 7.2. Hold a valid identity document and have adequate proof of residence as required by RICA laws.

Entries

8. Only one entry per participant will be accepted.
9. Incomplete or incorrect entries will not be eligible to be entered into the draw.
10. Entries may be made by the Participant or by a third party on the Participant's behalf with the Participant's acquired permission.
11. Participants must submit all entry requirements on www.switch.awardsplatform.com accordingly.
12. Entrants must submit all requirements before 31 August 2023.
13. Entries must be concept form only as stipulated above. No prototypes will be accepted. Further, entries must include a product description (minimum of 150 words) as well as an entrant biography (minimum of 150 words) and an entrant photograph. Entrant photographs will be used should the entrant achieve 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place.
14. Designs must not be manufactured.
15. Entrants will be required to design an automatic solar tracker that is innovative, functional, and aesthetically appealing.
16. Designs must be original. Any entries which infringe on creative copyright will be immediately disqualified.
17. Entrants will receive a confirmation email of entry in the Competition.
18. Images must not contain the name or logo of the entrant, designer, architect, firm, company, client or manufacturer anywhere on the image of the file.
19. All images submitted are released by the designer for use by the Promoters for the purposes of the Competition.



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20. All winning designs and images are released by the designer to become the sole property of the Promoters for the purposes of this competition and future manufacturing if applicable.
21. Should the winning design entrant wish to have their design manufactured, ACDC Express will assist in creating an online crowdfunding page in support of the winner. All funds will belong to the design entrant and not ACDC Express.

Voting and Prizes

22. The Top 10 successful entries will be selected by a panel no later than the close of business, 31 October 2023.
23. The winners will be announced on 1 December 2023.
24. The Judging panel will select a first, second and third place winner from the Top 10 entrants whereby the winners will be awarded the following:
 - 24.1. First Place Entry: R100 000.00 (Hundred Thousand Rand) as a cash prize and a featured blog in the Visi Magazine.
 - 24.2. Second Place Entry: R50 000 (Fifty Thousand Rand) as a cash prize and a blog post to be featured in the Visi Magazine.
 - 24.3. Third Place Entry: R20 000 (Twenty Thousand Rand) as a cash prize and a blog post to be featured in the Visi Magazine.
 - 24.4. Cash prizes may not be exchanged for any products, services or the like thereof.
25. The judge's selection is final.
26. The Judge's prizes may not be exchanged for cash, products, services or the like thereof.
27. The potential for manufacturing and funding will be discussed with the winners post Competition. This will entail a crowdfunding initiative. No guarantee of such is granted.
28. Prizes must be claimed within 6 (six) months of winners being announced.



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29. The Promoters reserve the right to substitute prizes for an alternative prize of equal or greater value should the prizes promoted not be available due to unforeseen circumstances.
30. The Promoters will not be liable for any loss suffered as a result of incomplete or incorrect information provided.
31. The Promoters reserve the right to withhold prizes in the event that they reasonably believe, in their sole discretion, that the winner is not eligible to win, has contravened any of these terms and conditions, has acted in a manner that is not in the spirit of the competition, their conduct can be reasonably interpreted as scamming or circumventing the rules of the Competition, acted fraudulently with regards to the competition, if it would be unlawful to award the prize or if the winner failed to accept the prize within the stipulated period. In this instance winner(s) will be disqualified and the prize(s) will be forfeited. The Promoters' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

33. The Promoters are not responsible for any technical failures affecting participation in the campaign and they assume no liability in this regard.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, by participating, the Participant indemnifies, releases and agrees to hold harmless the Promoters, their associated, holding and subsidiary companies, and its directors, officers, agents, representatives, shareholders, employees, successors and assigns from any and all claims or liability arising from participating in this Competition, any Competition-related activity and/or acceptance, receipt, possession or use/misuse of any prize.

To the extent permitted by law, the Promoters will not be liable in any way whatsoever, for any claims arising from loss, injury, damage or costs, suffered by a Participant in relation to this Competition or the prizes offered, including but not limited to claims relating to defects in the prizes or any losses caused by such defects or losses arising from incorrect or inaccurate information supplied by Participants.
36. The Promoters will not be liable for any loss suffered as a result of incomplete or incorrect information provided.
